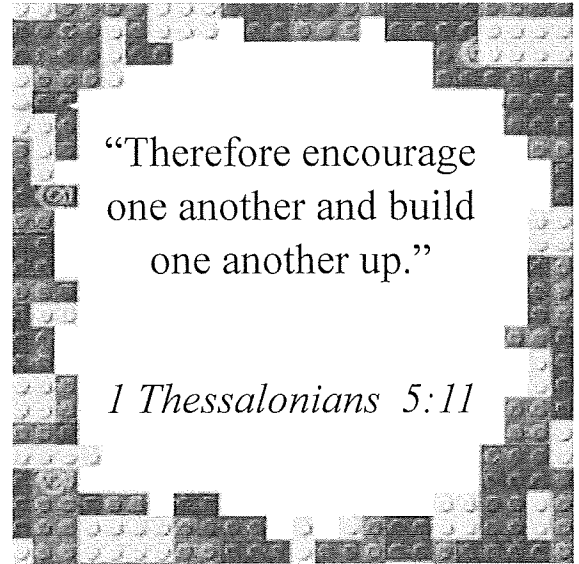

**Mosquitos and EEE**—While we have not been confirmed as a county with EEE virus, several counties surrounding us have.
