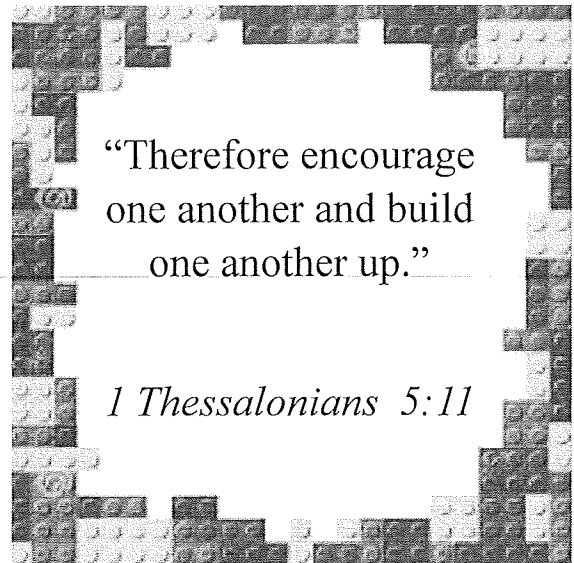

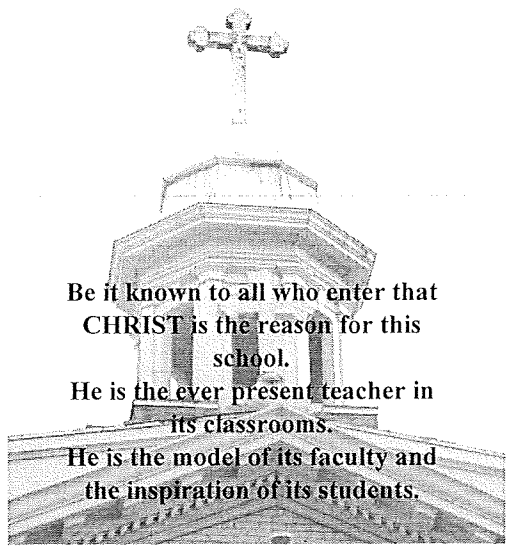
The Mission of Saints Peter and Paul School is to provide a high quality Catholic education in a Catholic Christian environment.
