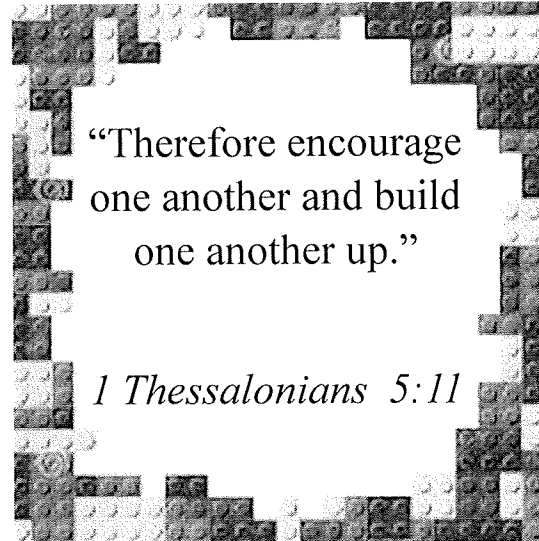

2020/2021 Scholarships— Families wishing to apply for scholarships for the 2020-21 school year will need to complete the Smart Aid application. Applications and complete instructions are available by following the links below: Applications and supporting document deadlines:

Any and all scholarships are awarded to families that have submitted a Smart Aid application and meet scholarship requirements. Scholarships are reviewed and awarded on a first-come, first-served basis to eligible families. Even if your family does not qualify for the Bishop Scholarship from the Diocese, your application through Smart Aid is needed for the school to award aid through the Saints Peter and Paul Scholarship Fund .

Parent Meeting—A whole school parent meeting has been scheduled for **January 22nd at 6:30pm.** This meeting will be considered mandatory and it is important for all parents to participate. We will be discussing becoming ambassadors for our school, student activities and ways to help our school grow. Our Youth Group will be on hand to watch children during the meeting and a free will donation will be collected on behalf of the Youth Group for this service.
