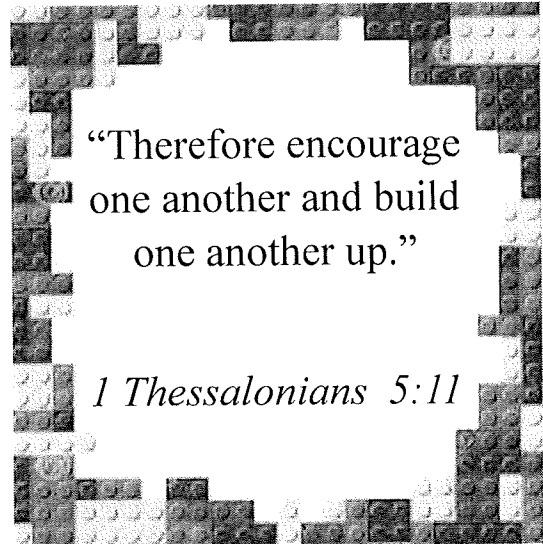

Any and all scholarships are awarded to families that have submitted a Smart Aid application and meet scholarship requirements. Scholarships are reviewed and awarded on a first-come, first-served basis to eligible families. Even if your family does not qualify for the Bishop Scholarship from the Diocese, your application through Smart Aid is needed for the school to award aid through the Saints Peter and Paul Scholarship Fund .

Enrollment - Saints Peter and Paul will open up enrollment for 2020/2021 school year within the next two weeks. At this time, we are waiting for the tuition rate to be approved by the school board. Once the rate is approved, online enrollment will be opened. Please watch Remind, Facebook and the Panther Press for enrollment details.

It is important for you to register as soon as possible so that proper planning can take place for next school year. Registering early also allows you to receive a discounted registration fee and be entered into our early registration drawing.


The Mission of Saints Peter and Paul School is to provide a high quality Catholic education in a Catholic Christian environment.
