Scholarships are reviewed and awarded on a first-come, first-served basis to eligible families. Even if your family does not qualify for the Bishop Scholarship from the Diocese, your application through Smart Aid is needed for the school to award aid through the Saints Peter and Paul Scholarship Fund.

<u>New Scholarship Opportunity</u>—The Faith and Future Scholarship was recently announced by the Diocese! Each student enter Kindergarten or 6th grade has the opportunity to receive \$100 off their tuition! If you attended Preschool or 5th grade with us, you are eligible for an extra \$50 off! This is a separate application from Smart Aid. If you need help, please contact the school office!
