

<u>Parent/Teacher Conferences:</u> K-8 Grade Parents—Please fill out and return the Conference Time Request form sent home today. It is due to your child's teacher by Monday. We will schedule conferences at a staff meeting on Wednesday and your times will be sent home next Friday, November 11th. Conferences will be held on November 21st and 22nd.

**The Bishop's Visit:** We are so blessed to have Bishop Walkowiak visit us on Tuesday of this past week. We celebrated All Saints Day Mass with him, and then he and Fr. Tom visited all of the classrooms to speak with the students. Bishop Walkowiak even ate lunch with the students—sharing 7th grader JG's birthday lunch! It was a wonderful day!

<u>Halloween and Trunk-or-Treat at SSPP:</u> Thank you so much to the Family School Council and all of our parent helpers who made Halloween special for our students at SSPP. Trunk or Treat at the bowling alley went very smoothly and the students very much enjoyed the treats and games! Congratulations to the Ferris's and Heinlein (grandparents) who won the trunk decorating contest this year. Many thanks to the bowling alley for graciously letting us use their parking lot.

<u>Lunch Time Helpers:</u> Many thanks to our parents who come to help with lunch recess. We have a faithful group who come very regularly which is very helpful in adding consistency to behavioral expectations on the playground! We are always looking for new helpers who are VIRTUS trained, and especially need assistance on rainy days when we can't go outside and recess is held in the classrooms.

Fall/Winter: I am sure winter weather will eventually begin. Please watch the weather and send your child to school prepared for outdoor recesses. In general, we go outside unless the wind chill drops below 0°. We even go outside when it is raining lightly. In addition to winter coats, all students in grades PS-4 should have clothing items that provide comfort on cold days (hats, gloves, snow pants, boots, etc.) Students who are not wearing boots and snow pants are not allowed to play in the snow. Everyone goes outside, even if they do not have hats, gloves, etc. Older students should have hats, gloves, and girls who are wearing skirts or skorts should have leggings to wear at recess time. If the older students wish to play in the snow, they also need to have boots and snow pants. Students who are well enough to go to school are well enough to go outdoors unless a note from a doctor suggests otherwise. Cold weather does not cause illness, so a doctor's note is a rare occurrence and is usually associated with chronic asthma.
