Dear Parents,

I hope that the summer has been kind to you and that you are refreshed and ready to kick off the school year. Below you will find a table that is a quick guide to our Back to School COVID plan. This plan is subject to change based on any mandates set forth on the federal or local level.

Face to face learning is a very important experience to offer our students. However, please note that online learning will occur if required due to COVID quarantines, when mandated or if there is a lack of staff/substitutes due to illness.

Please note, that any and all changes will be communicated quickly and efficiently.

Learning Model	Saints Peter and Paul will conduct in-person learning for the 2021/2022 school year.
Masks	Masks are not required, but are strongly recommended. Masks are required for all public transport, including school buses.
Distancing	Distancing will be encouraged, when possible. All classrooms will be set up with as much distancing as space allows.
Cleaning	Daily cleaning will continue during the lunch period. Each individual classroom and surfaces that are frequently touched will be disinfected.
COVID Vaccination	Recommend by the CDC for all those who are eligible. Not required as part of the School Required Vaccination List.
Ventilation	Classrooms will open windows and doors to provide maximum ventilation when possible. Teachers may use outdoor space for learning when feasible.
Sick Students/Staff Members	Parents and staff members will screen daily at home. All students and staff members who have any symptoms of illness MUST remain home and report the absence and symptoms to the school office as normal.

Daily Screening

When screening your child at home, please be sure to take their temperature and note any new or worsen symptoms.

Temperatures WILL NOT be taken at the door this year.

Isolation and Quarantine

Students and staff members will be required to quarantine if

- they are a household member of a positive case.
- they are considered a close contact of a school outbreak.

Please note, that there are other circumstances that a quarantine may be recommended.

If and when a quarantine becomes required or recommended, a phone call will be made to the families directly from the school. Quarantine options can be discussed at that time based on the recommendations of the local health department.

Athletics

Athletics are currently scheduled to be completed as normal.

Visitor Policy

All visitors should self-screen before coming to the building. Upon arrival, all visitors must check into the office and accurately note their destination within the school.
