

Curriculum/Special Services/Activities

Saints Peter and Paul Catholic School follows the Grand Rapids Diocesan curriculum and provides each student with the opportunity for academic success. Each student progresses at a level that challenges his/her abilities and learning style.

Core Curriculum Subjects Are:

Religion Phonics (K-2)
Mathematics Science Social Studies
Language Arts (Reading, Grammar, Spelling, Writing, Listening and Speaking)

Additional Courses Offered Include:

Music (K-5) Band (6-8) Art
Physical Education Computers Library (K-5)

After-hours tutoring by teachers is available in grades K-8, in addition to after-school Homework Club offered two afternoons each week.

Testing:

Students in grades 2-8 take the NWEA Test.

Special Services:

Special Services are offered through the Ionia Intermediate School District. These services include a teacher consultant, school psychologist, speech pathologist, diagnostic testing, vision and hearing screening. Services may be requested at any time by the parent or teacher. Parental permission is always obtained before observations can take place.

Extracurricular Activities:

Different sports are offered at different grade levels based on the number of interested students. These may include basketball, volleyball and cheerleading. Students at SSPP regularly compete successfully in the Science Olympiad, Spelling Bees and Geography Bees. Other opportunities for academic competition are considered as they arise. Chorus is available in grades 3-8 and the Christmas Choir includes students at all levels for our annual Christmas Extravaganza.

Club opportunities are made available based on interest level.

Other programs which have been available include DARE (grade 6).
